



Directions to WPI's Higgins House Parking Lot and then to the Campus Center for WPI Venture Forum Programs

Set your vehicle navigation system to 1 John Wing Road, Worcester, MA, or, follow these simple directions.

From the Mass Turnpike

Mass Turnpike (I-90) to **Exit 10A** (RT 146). At end of ramp, turn right, follow signs for RT 146 North/Worcester. At the end of RT 146, stay right and enter **I-290 East** drive until you see **Exit 17, RT 9** (Ware/Framingham). Turn left at top of ramp onto RT 9/Belmont Street and move into the right lane. Before the second traffic light, merge right onto Lincoln Street. Move immediately into the left lane. At the first traffic light, curve left onto Salisbury Street. Proceed through three traffic lights and past several side streets, the art museum on the left, and a park on the right. John Wing Road is on the left, just before the Park Avenue intersection. It is a narrow, oak-tree lined entrance that looks like a private driveway. Turn in and make an immediate right into the parking lot.

From the North

Take I-495 south to I-290 west into Worcester. Take Exit 18 (Lincoln Sq., Rte. 9), turn right at end of ramp, stay in right lane, merging right at fork before traffic light. This is the start of Salisbury Street. Proceed through three traffic lights and past several side streets. Pass the art museum on the left, a park on the right, and turn left onto **John Wing Road**, just before the Park Avenue intersection. It is a narrow, oak-tree lined entrance that looks like a private driveway. Make an immediate right into the parking lot.

Walking to the Campus Center Building from the Higgins House Parking Lot

WPI Venture Forum programs are held in the Campus Center building, located behind the Higgins House to the right. Walk under the brick arch (left of the house and pictured above) up a small set of stairs. At the top, take the blacktop path to the right directly to the patio area at the back of the Campus Center building, entering there on the first floor. Take the elevator or stairs to the third floor where programs are held in the Odeum room.
